**Linda Asmus ~
Watercolor Demonstration**

The December BAA meeting is the one in which we have a demonstration by a member artist. This year's artist will be Linda Asmus. If you have seen Linda's watercolors at shows, you must have wondered how to get such amazingly intense colors. Now you can find out. Linda will use a slideshow to demonstrate how she gets a painting started in order to obtain a unique result with watercolor. The key is preparing the paper with an acrylic seal and using a dry brush technique. Several finished painting will be on display.

To get there just follow the parking lot around to the left of the school and head to the back. You can unload your vehicle at one of the doors. Charles DeMarco at the October Meeting

Our presenter for the October meeting was watercolorist Charles DeMarco. In his presentation Charles began with the elements of design and the importance of preparation for your painting. He particularly stressed the need for a value study to guide the work. Other things to remember are to stand back from your work from time to time and to not rush to color. At the end Charles compared the painting he had been working on in the demonstration with a version of the same scene that he had done more than a decade earlier. It was very interesting to see how his technique has evolved over the years.
